- ★ \$1,885,000 total Fundraising to date since 2005
- ★ Over \$400,000 since 2006 has been used to fund mammograms, ultrasounds, and biopsies

BREAST CANCER FACTS — DENSE BREAST TISSUE

DENSE BREAST TISSUE IS COMPRISED OF LESS FAT AND MORE CONNECTIVE TISSUE which appears white on a mammogram. It's estimated about 40 percent of women have dense tissue, and the percentage may be even higher in the Gunnison Valley. A woman's risk of breast cancer increases with the density of her tissue, and younger, healthier women have an increased likelihood of dense tissue.

- ★ Breast density is one of the strongest predictors of the failure of mammography screening to detect cancer
- ★ Two-thirds of pre-menopausal women and 1/4 of post menopausal women have dense breast tissue
- ★ Adding more sensitive tests to mammography significantly increase detection of invasive cancers that are small and node negative
- ★ Cancer turns up five times more often in women with extremely dense breasts than those with the most fatty tissue
- ★ While a mammogram detects 98% of cancers in women with fatty breasts, it finds only 48% in women with the densest breasts
- ★ A woman at average risk and a woman at high risk have an EQUAL chance of having their cancer masked by mammogram
- ★ Women with dense breasts who had breast cancer have a four times higher risk of recurrence than women with less-dense breasts
