- ★ \$1,635,000 total funds raised since 2005
- ★ \$260,000.00 Raised in 2015
- ★ \$373,000 funded in mammograms, ultrasounds and biopsies since 2006
- ★ \$75,000 in 2015 to help purchase vacuum assisted equipment to allow us to perform ultrasound guided biopsies and stereotactic biopsies at Gunnison Valley Health and prevent patients having to travel to other healthcare centers for these services
- ★ \$2,228 in 2015 to *Living Journeys* to fund individual and group therapy for emotional support
- ★ \$2,000 to Casting for Recovery to send two Gunnison County ladies to the 2016 Fly Fishing Retreat for breast cancer survivors
- ★ \$2,500 in 2015 through Friends of Pink to provide assistance to individuals diagnosed with breast cancer who are impacted financially

- ★ Robes & robe warmers purchased for mammogram patients in 2012


