MANIMO MONDAYS

Women who get their Mammograms on select Mondays each month will receive a complimentary massage or orthobionomy session from GVH's Integrative Therapies program. TETWP helps to provide life saving mammograms and other necessary breast cancer screenings for those who do not have insurance. Over the last few years TETWP has ramped up our awareness campaign around the importance of screening for breast cancer resulting in a 40% increase from 2017 to 2019 in the number of women getting their annual mammogram!

CUNNISON VALLEY HEALTH

TETWP has a strategic plan in partnership with Gunnison Valley Health to help provide GVH with state of the art equipment, physicians, and services to be the best small town cancer care hospital in the USA. In 2020 TETWP is purchasing an MRI coil so that women can get all of the necessary screenings for breast cancer here at GVH. 3D Mammograms, ultrasounds, stereotactic biopsies, and now breast MRI will be available with top of the line equipment.

PROGRAMS FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH ANY FORM OF CANCER:

FUCLYS THANKS to a generous donation from Dorothy and Norman Eastwood TETWP was able to start the Lucy's House program. The program helps to cover the cost of lodging for people that have to stay away from home to access life saving treatments. Over the last year the Lucy's House program has covered 143 nights of lodging for individuals with ALL types of cancer. Helping them to stay close to where they receive their treatments and ease some of the stress experienced by individuals and families dealing with a cancer diagnosis.

MAKE IT A GREAT DAY: TETWP coupons will be provided to cancer patients and/or their caregivers to use for integrative therapies such as reiki, massage, acupuncture, light therapy, nutrition, orthobionomy, etc. These therapies have been proven to help cancer patients stay strong mentally and physically while they are going through their surgeries and treatments. Research findings show that integrative therapies can help to boost the immune system, reduce pain and help patients stay strong.
