Over four million dollars have been raised to help our community, in small and big ways. From buying tanks of gas and groceries, to providing the state-of-the-art equipment, TETWP is here for our local friends and families—from life-saving screenings and diagnosis, through treatment, recovery and return to a full life after cancer.

- Total fundraising since 2005 is **\$4,392,000**
- 2021 fundraising campaigns raised **\$650,000**
- 2021 - **\$33,000.00** raised through **Pedal For Pink**
- 2020 - **\$147,000** to purchase a **Breast MRI Coil** for Gunnison Valley Health (GVH)
- 2019 - **\$160,000** to purchase a **Breast Stereotactic Biopsy Device** for GVH
- **Lucy's House** - **\$34,000** since 2019 through providing lodging assistance to individuals with any type of cancer.
- 2017 - **\$370,000** to purchase a **Hologic 3D Tomosynthesis Machine** for GVH. Proven to detect 20%-65% more invasive breast cancers and reduce callbacks by up to 40% compared to 2D alone. FDA approved as superior for women with dense breasts.
- **\$120,000** funded to individuals for mammograms, ultrasounds, MRI's and biopsies since 2013 to cover the cost of life saving breast cancer screenings for those who do not have health insurance coverage.
- Support For Our Local Hospital - Over **\$1,400,000** has been used since 2006 to purchase equipment (Breast MRI Coil, 3D Tomosynthesis, ultrasound, digital mammography, stereotactic biopsy, PINK robes and warmers) to expand breast cancer services at Gunnison Valley Hospital to make this the best small-town breast cancer facility in the US.
- Tough Enough To Wear Pink also covers **30% of the salary for the Oncology Nurse Navigator** hired to help all cancer patients in the Gunnison Valley to navigate the complexities of treatments, medications, insurance, transportation, and provide support and assistance throughout all stages of the cancer continuum.
- **"Tuffy" the Transportation Ram Truck** purchased in 2016 and **"Bucky" the Dodge Durango** purchased in 2018 help all cancer patients get to their out of town medical appointments safely and comfortably. They have traveled over 130,000 miles across the state. TETWP welcomed a third vehicle, Betty Ann, donated in 2020!
- **\$190,000** granted since 2015 through the **Friends of Pink** program to help individuals in the Gunnison Valley who were impacted financially due to a breast cancer diagnosis (lost wages, travel expenses for treatment, etc.)

Our Make It A Great Day program is now open to the caregivers so they can get a moment to destress utilizing the many services the department offers including massage, ortho bionomy, acupuncture and reiki.

This summer, Kevin and his daughter, 9-year-old Abby, embarked on a journey, cross country, 4,200 miles, from Seattle to Maine. They pedaled for Pink. Fueled by extra love and passion for this trip as they are navigating their wife and mother Jennifer's breast cancer diagnosis.

"**Every day is a new day**," said Jennifer when talking to Executive Director of TETWP, Heidi Sherratt when she and Kevin sat down to share their story. Knowing that every day is a new day, opens a world of positivity and hope whether you're biking across the country or battling breast cancer. In a joint effort with the Sanderfords, Gunnison TETWP spread awareness, shared inspiration, and raised money on a national scale to support other cancer patients and their families in our community.

Kevin and Abby left their home in Crested Butte, CO on Friday, June 4th to travel to their starting line in Anacortes, Washington. They began pedaling for Pink on Monday, June 7th, 2021. They completed their journey in Bar Harbor, Maine on August 15th, 2021.

October Breast Cancer Awareness

Gunnison Valley Health is fortunate to have a Hologic 3D Tomosynthesis mammography machine, making GVH the best in the state for breast imaging. 3D mammography is the gold standard for screening, and is capable of detecting a cancerous growth as small as a grain of sand. 3D mammography causes less discomfort than previous technology, which is a common concern among women who have not been screened before. It's never too early to start getting regular mammograms! If you do not have insurance please do not let this stop you from getting your life saving mammogram! TETWP will cover the cost of your mammogram or deductible when you get it at Gunnison Valley Hospital if you do not have adequate coverage.






